The **UTAH MIATA CLUB** is Hosting their “**Miatas in Utah**” event for **2014** at **BRYCE CANYON, UTAH** in Southwestern Utah from **Wednesday, July 2 thru Sunday, July 6, 2014**. The Host Hotel is the **Best Western Bryce Canyon Grand Hotel**.

Accommodations can also be made at the Grand’s sister hotel, the Best Western **Ruby’s Inn**, located directly across the street. Both hotels are rated as Best Western Plus hotels. They also have a **campground and RV Park**.

Cost of the event is \$45.00 per person. Registration must be made in Advance by click on the above menu (“**On Line Registration**”) and fill out the form completely and click “**Submit**”. It is that simple. *(Please indicate by name which Best Western Hotel you are staying at). You can pay by **Pay Pal** or mail in a **Check or Money Order made out to Utah Miata Club** to UMC Treasurer at 1405 East Center St., Bountiful, UT. 84010. *Note: On PayPal payment you will be required to manually fill in # of

attendees if bringing spouse or another person with you as it will only show 1 person. **Two persons Fee is \$90.00.** Paragraph on bottom of Registration Form indicates what is included in the event for the fee. **Mail In:** You can also download a Registration Form in pdf format and manually fill it out and mail it in with your check or money order. To do that, use drop the down box titled "Mail In Registration".

Event Check In: Check in will be at selected times from about 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday and also on Thursday and Friday at selected times which will be posted on White Boards. Check in will be in the **Cottonwood Room**, which is located in the south wing of the Grand, Host Hotel. Goodie bags will be given out to paid attendees filled with exciting items like an Event Pin and other goodies.

NOTE on Social Gatherings: Thursday, July 3rd **WELCOME SOCIAL:** A "Welcome Social" will be held Thursday evening at the **Red Canyon Room** in Ruby's Hotel. Appetizers and hors d'oeuvres will be served. A Cash Bar will be available for attendees. We will also be having **Prize drawings** for Miata related items and music and entertainment. There is **NO Cost** for this as it is included in your Registration Fee.

Saturday evening Event Program and Dinner, Prize Give-aways: Dinner cost will be an extra charge, not included in Registration Fee. Dinner Fee will be paid at Check-In at event and a **Dinner Voucher** will be given attendee for attendance at Program for your pre-selected meal. Dinner food option will be selected in advance by attendee (details to follow later). Dinner options will be 14 oz. Rib Eye Steak (approx. cost: \$29.00, Salmon \$26.00, or Chicken/BBQ Pork \$23.50). Meals include Cowboy Beans, Dutch Oven Potatoes, Vegetable, Creamy Coleslaw, Rolls, Dessert, Soft Drink or Coffee. A Cash Bar will also be available. You must purchase dinner option to be eligible for all Miata and Mazda Logo Prizes and Merchandise that will be given away during the program. Thousands of dollars in prizes will be awarded like we have done in our past Miatas in Utah events (Miatas in Moab I-V in years 2003-2010. Similar activities to take place).

Click on your Hotel preference and it will take you directly to Reservation page with dates and daily cost of the room. **All Rooms have been discounted 40% off regular rate for this event.** **Rate at Host Hotel, Bryce Canyon Grand is \$142.00 per night and includes a Full Breakfast Buffet. Ruby's**

Inn rate is \$99.00 per night (breakfast not included in this price). Fill in the blanks with type of beds you want in your room and hold your room with a credit card. Note: Credit card must have expiration date after date of event or it may be declined. If your card expires, just put in the following year's expiration date and you should be ok

BRYCE CANYON: [Bryce Canyon](#) is famous for it's worldly unique geology and consists of a series of horseshoe-shaped amphitheaters carved from the eastern edge of the Paunsaugnt Plateau. The erosional force of frost-wedging and the dissolving power of rainwater have shaped the colorful limestone rock of the Claron Formation into bizarre shapes, including slot canyons, windows, fins, and spires called "hoodoos". Bryce Canyon and the local area offers many hiking opportunities right off the road for easy access to view these beautiful formations. We will feature information in our Goody Bags on area attractions.
